NOTES:

1. The **FUND ALLOCATION CHANGE FORM** is used to indicate how future deposits are to be applied to the unit account. The percentage of the deposit to be applied to each fund is entered in the column NEW FUND SPLIT. The total of all percentages must not exceed 100%.
2. The **FUND TRANSFER FORM** is used when a transfer of existing units is being requested. The transfer can be specified in terms of:
 - a. An amount of unit value, using the AMOUNT columns. The value in the Amount column cannot exceed the values currently reflected in the funds individually or totally.
 - b. A percentage amount of unit value, using the % OF FUNDS columns. The total percentage on the TRANSFER UNITS TO: section must equal 100%.
3. There is a charge for the service of transferring existing units from one fund to another. The charge depends on how frequently such transfers are requested and is a percentage amount applied to the amount of money transferred. The charges are subject to change without notice.
