

## SAGICOR AT LLOYD'S ON THE FAST TRACK

Every year in London, staff members of insurance-related companies participate in what has been described as “the Industry’s Premier Kart Racing Event.” As reported in the September issue of Insurance Times (IT) in the UK, “It proved to be one of the closest races in Daytona’s checkered history, as Lamp Insurance staged a dramatic comeback to clinch its first title ahead of valiant Sagicor, who, picking up exactly where the old Gerling team left off, had to settle for second place for the fourth consecutive year.” But it wasn’t an easy victory for the winner, and those eight hours must have been grueling. According to IT, “Sagicor took the lead at the three-hour mark, by which point Lamp, having fallen out of the running in the early stages, had moved up to second. A hundred laps later, the two remained locked in battle.”

“After over 300 grueling laps, Sagicor remained a nose in front. But Lamp would not be denied. Aided in no small part by producing the fastest lap of the race at 1:09.12 - scarcely more than a second shy of the track record - and some expertly timed driver changes, they finally took and held the lead.”

Even though Sagicor once again finished runners-up, they really appreciated being able to participate in such a well-run and closely-fought event, and hope to find the elusive 40-odd seconds needed to top the podium next year.
