WHAT DOCUMENTS WILL I NEED? Wondering what you need? Prepare these documents ahead of time. For a mortgage on an existing property: A letter from your employer indicating present salary, position and length of service. Proof of Identity Proof of down payment and source of funds (copies of at least 3 month's recent bank statements). If you are self-employed, the last three years' financial statements and copies of your income tax returns. Letter of offer from the seller of the property supported by a valuation of the property by one of Sagicor's approved valuers. Banker's reference. A copy of the plot plan and proof of ownership (Conveyance/Certificate of Title). For a mortgage to build:
